<b>Start with the Right Pilot</b>	Identify a visible, representative project	Capture baseline quality and review effort	Expand pilots to adjacent teams or domains	Use pilots to onboard new divisions or standards
<b>Centralize Rules &amp; Configurations</b>	Define a core rule set aligned to standards	Apply rules consistently across pilot artifacts	Refine rules based on feedback and data	Maintain and evolve rules centrally
<b>Measure Consistently &amp; Track Progress</b>	Establish initial quality metrics	Track before-and-after improvements	Compare trends across projects	Use metrics for executive reporting and audits
<b>Balance Automation &amp; Human Expertise</b>	Introduce automated checks as reviewer support	Shift guidance earlier into authoring	Optimize division of effort between tools and experts	Continuously tune automation and review practices
<b>Plan for Change Management</b>	Communicate intent and expected value	Share early wins and lessons learned	Formalize training and onboarding	Reinforce quality as part of standard practice
